

In accordance with the Certification and Agreement of the Coronavirus Act, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") Midland University is posting the following required information. This information is required to be posted as of June 1, 2020 and updated every 45 days by the University.

Midland University signed and returned Certification and Agreement documents of the CARES Act to the Department of Education. Midland received a total allocation of \$1,102,337 (\$551,169 was allocated on May 1 and \$551,168 was allocated on May 4). Midland University will use 50%, (or \$551,169) of the allocation from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Midland University has elected to award the HEERF Grants to the following students who were enrolled as of March 9, 2020:

Full-Time, Fremont Campus, Undergraduate Students, living off campus: \$250

Full-Time, Fremont Campus, Undergraduate Students, living on campus: \$500

The remaining HEERF funds will be awarded to any eligible Midland student (regardless of location, program or credits taken) who have demonstrated need or additional need due to the impact of the COVID-19 crisis. Students seeking additional aid can apply [here](#).

As of October 13, 2020 Midland University has successfully awarded 703 students \$341,200 in grant aid.
