

Payment Options

Midland University offers multiple options for you to pay your portion of your educational costs. You may choose one or a combination of these options.

Please note Midland bills by semester and requires all bills to be paid in full by the first day of the semester, or requires that a payment plan is in place. You will have the opportunity to adjust your payment method from semester to semester or renew your plan from the previous semester.

To make a payment on your account:

- Online Payments can be submitted through the Warrior Central Portal at anytime by clicking on the "Manage My Account" Nelnet link.
- Pay in person with Cash, Check, or Money Order at our Student Billing Office Monday-Friday 8-4:30.
- Mail Check or Money Order to:

Payment Plans:

You may set up a Midland University Nelnet Payment Plan. Enrolling in an interest-free payment plan allows a student to split their total educational costs into monthly payments.

Please note that while no interest is charged, an enrollment fee of \$25 per semester is assessed and you must sign up for a new payment plan each semester.

Payment plans can be discussed during New Student Registration Days and are available to begin July 2020 for the upcoming school year.

College Savings Plans:

If you have a College Savings Plan, please know that our Student Billing Office accepts this funding source as well. Simply let your 529 servicer know the amount you are requesting and provide them with the Student Billing address listed above. They will mail a check directly to Midland University on your behalf.
